MANNA PROGRAM

Manna program food distribution phase 3 has concluded successfully. We had the full participation of 20 mums; the highest amount saved was UGX 640,000(170\$) and most of the participating mothers saved between UGX 244,000- 370,000 (50\$-100\$). We are very proud of them.

TUESDAY BIBLE STUDY

The bible study sessions have registered amazing growth from the beginning of this year. This is largely because several mothers are encouraging their neighbors and friends to attend. So many souls have come to Christ as we have been reporting this month. We had 6 more mothers joining our Christian faith and many more continuing to be strengthened in the word of God despite the life challenges being experienced in their lives. We have seen this through the testimonies shared during the Bible study.



COUNSELLING SESSIONS

Apart from financial needs, some mothers deal with personal challenges like, HIV AIDS, infections, malnourished Children, early pregnancies, domestic violence and many others. Mama Tulia provides counselling sessions to help the mothers cope up with these. We have Nurse Agnes who always gets time to talk to these women and offers counselling and medical advice. Our staff also extends a hand in listening, advising and standing with them in prayer too.



MAMAKIT DISTRIBUTION

We are happy to see how we're contributing towards the reduction of the mortality rate of mothers in the communities we serve in. In this fight we gave out 28 mama kits and 20 reusable diapers to contribute towards safe child birth. And among the moms, it has come to our notice that most of them are young mothers(teenagers). We're so thankful to you for enabling us stand with these mothers in their trying time.

HOME VISIT

Due to many challenges our mothers go through, Home visits are one of the ways we keep in touch with them. Visitors from Mercy for Mamas joined us during one of our out-reaches. They did some antenatal check ups and treated some babies. They also supported our mothers of premature babies with 10 manual breast pumps, BP monitor and baby clothes.





ELISABETH'S SURGERY

Elizabeth is a 22 yr old lady who we met at the Tuesday bible study. She had suffered emotionally, psychologically and socially after losing 3 of her babies at birth and soon after birth. The last one was a still birth and she had to be operated. Unfortunately, her wound got severely infected but thankfully she got treated. On the other hand, she had suffered from fistula causing her to have a very bad odor. She suffered for 4 months not until we were able to take her for another surgery to correct the fistula which was a success. She has spent 2 weeks in the hospital and we are happy to inform you that she has been discharged and she's recovering very well. We are glad that she'll gain back her confidence and respect in the community now. Thank you so much for the support you rendered towards this cause.

MEET SOFI NAMAGANDA

Sofi Namaganda a 15 year old young mum. She gave birth to this premature miracle baby weighing 1kg at home. She was rushed to a medical center near by and then transferred to a referral hospital in kawempe. We were contacted by a VHT(village health team) and we've been able to help with medical assistance, preemie kit and baby clothes during her stay at the hospital.

We are happy to report that she was discharged last week after being in the hospital for 1 month. We've offered continuous help during her stay at the hospital as mama Tulia and we are warmly welcoming her to the organization.
